### **Post-Doctoral Fellow**

**Position Description:** ClearWay Minnesota is an independent nonprofit organization that serves Minnesota through research grant-making, surveillance, cessation services, community capacity-building and statewide outreach through media campaigns. We are seeking applications for a Post-Doctoral Fellow to join our Research Department. This position provides an opportunity for new researchers interested in tobacco control to have a direct and applied experience. ClearWay Minnesota manages the Minnesota Adult Tobacco Survey (MATS), cross-sectional data on the tobacco-related attitudes, beliefs and behaviors of Minnesotans. In 2015, a cohort from MATS 2014 was followed to understand use of electronic cigarettes. With mentorship from ClearWay Minnesota research staff, the Post-Doctoral Fellow will be involved in analyzing these data, writing manuscripts and developing new research both to inform public health practice as well as program improvements for ClearWay Minnesota. ClearWay Minnesota also funds regulatory science research and manages the state's quitline (QUITPLAN<sup>®</sup> Helpline) and web-based intervention (quitplan.com), and this position provides an opportunity to be involved in the evaluation of these services. There are also opportunities to collaborate with other ClearWay Minnesota departments that focus on community development, public policy and mass media.

**Qualifications:** Applicants must have completed a doctoral-level degree in a health behavior-related discipline such as health education, health communications, health policy, psychology, or public health. Applicants are expected to have strong analytic and writing skills. U.S. citizenship or permanent residency is required. The position will be funded for one year with an option for a second year. The position has a flexible start date and can begin any time after February 1, 2016. Compensation will include a competitive package of salary and benefits.
